VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES HOSPITALITY AND EVENTS



OVERVIEW

Hospitality and event volunteers help with a variety of activities including Member and Artist Opening Receptions, gala events, lectures, First Fridays, Art Walk, and corporate bookings.

COMMITMENT

- Make a minimum commitment of 1 year
- Be available a minimum of 3 events per year (shifts can range between 3 and 6 hours)

TRAINING

- Attend hospitality training as required
- Attend exhibition cycle reviews to learn about new exhibitions, programs, events, and to develop professionally 2-3 times per year

*Complete Smart Serve certification if interested in serving alcohol at gallery events. Costs will be reimbursed by Gallery after one successful year of volunteering.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure visitors abide by gallery guidelines and reinforce the need for compliance, when necessary.
- Provide a positive visitor experience by maintaining a friendly and approachable manner when dealing with guests, staff, and other volunteers
- Be versed in gallery exhibitions, activities, programs, and events
- Assist with visitor checkin-ins at various events
- Serve food and beverage at special events
- Assist with a randy of duties including set-up and take down of tables, chairs, decorations, wine glasses, dishes, etc.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Interpersonal, communication, and customer service skills
- Have an interest in/or experience with a variety of art materials and activities

Credentials

- A satisfactory Police Vulnerable Sector Check. Costs reimbursed after one year of successful volunteering.

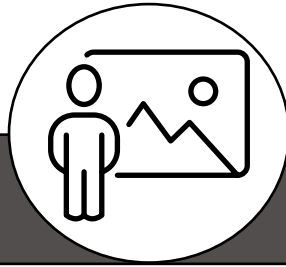

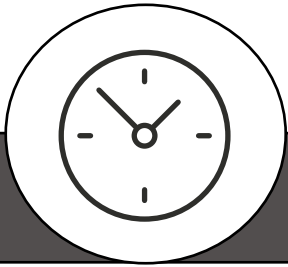

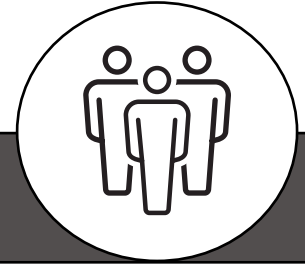
